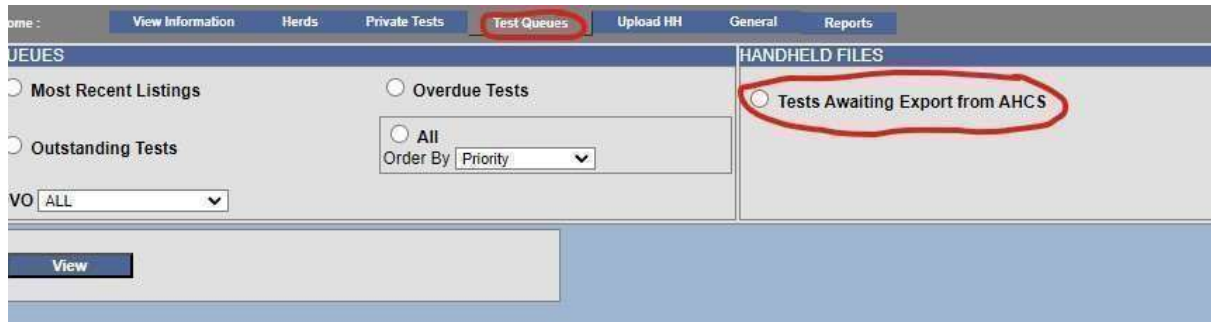


HOW TO UPLOAD A SINGLE TEST FILE FROM AHCS TO THE HANDHELD

Step 2. Click on **Test Queues** and Select **Tests Awaiting Export from AHCS**

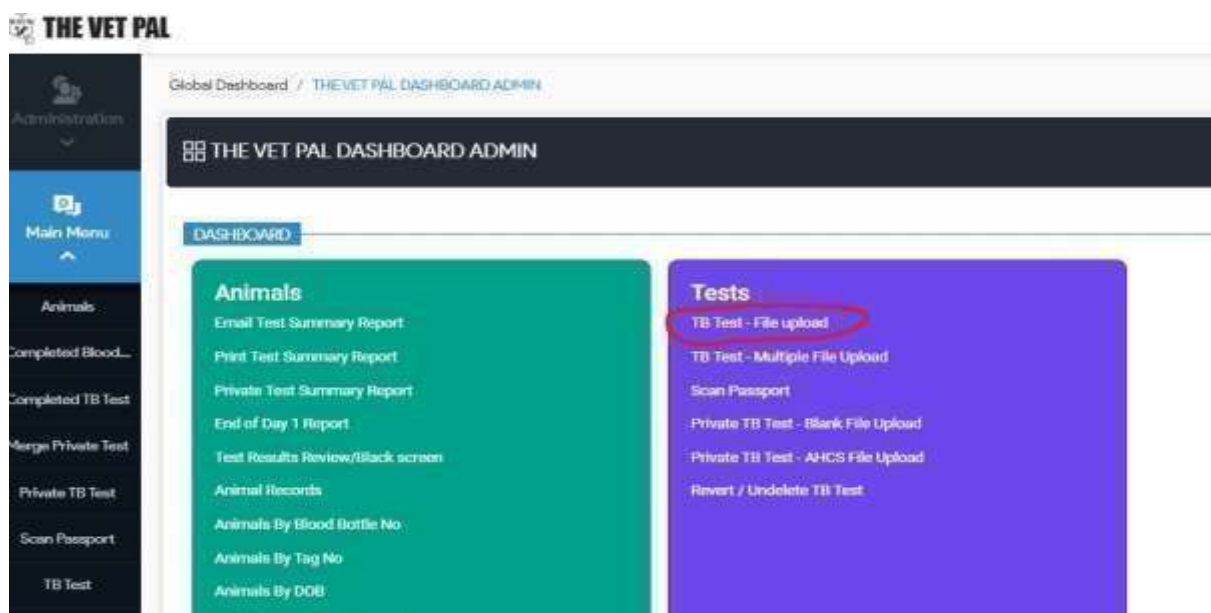


Step 3. Select the test and click **Create Export File**. This will automatically download a test file to your computer. Typically, you will find this file in your downloads folder.

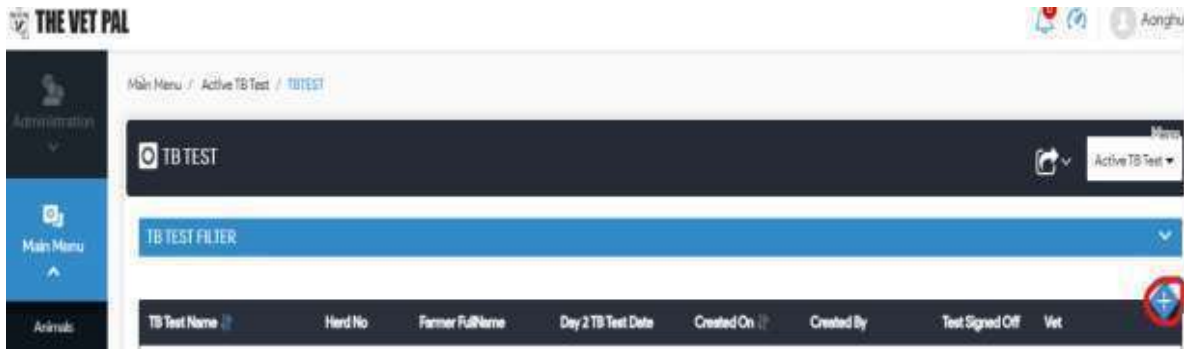

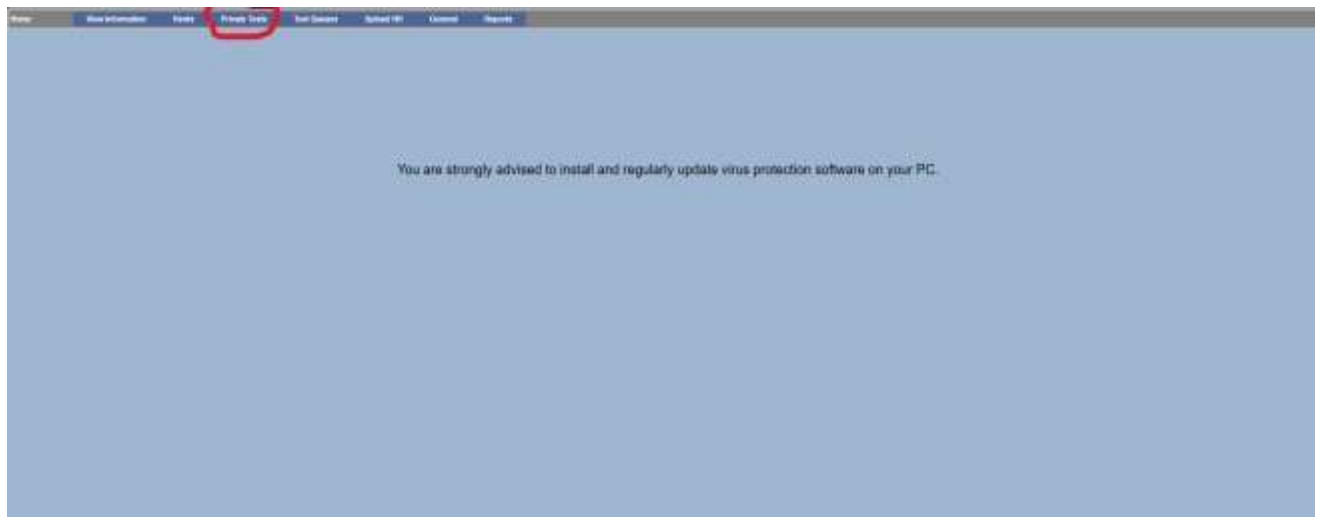

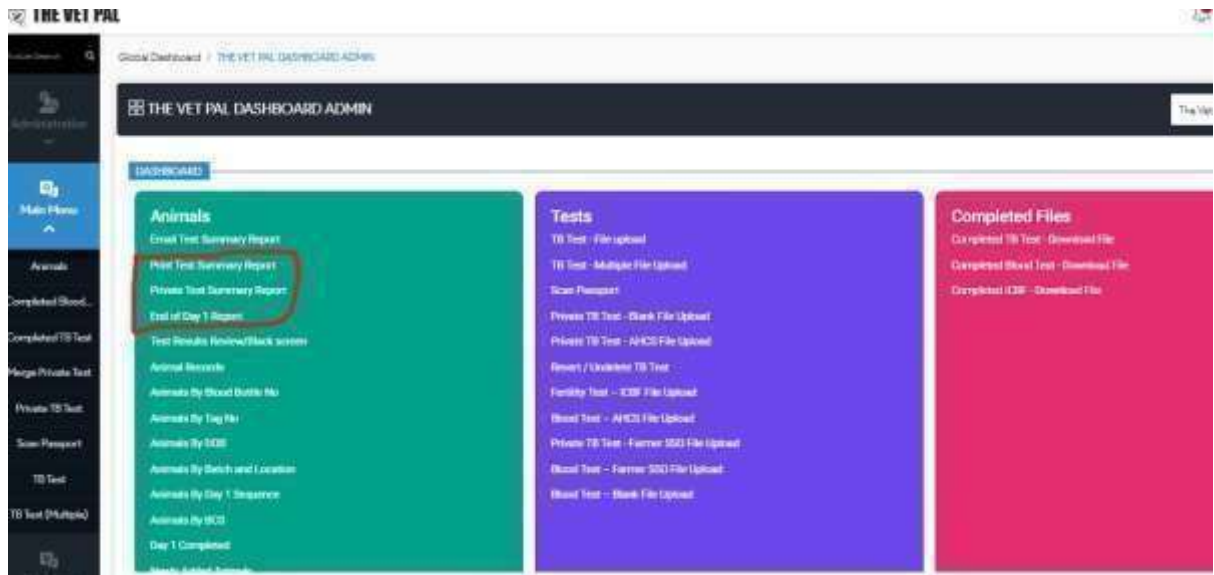
Step 4. Start scanning the cards and you will see the tag number appearing in the Animal Passport input field. As you scan the cards the Count which is circled below will increase. Once all the cards are scanned, those animals without passports will remain on the list below.



How to print Farmer Reports

Step 1. Log into <https://thevetpal.teamkonnnect.com/>

Step 2. Select one of the reports in the green box. I have circled the typical reports that most practices select. Please select the Private Test Summary Report for **private tests**. Please select Print Test Summary Report for **annual herd tests**..



Step 3. To select a specific test, please enter the Herd Number AND/OR Farmer name AND/OR Day 2 Test Range. For example if you wish to print a test report for Frank Doyle who had a TB test completed on 15/7/24, you could enter FRAN (FARMER FULL NAME) and enter 1/7/24 (DAY 2 TB TEST DATE FROM) and enter 20/7/24(DAY 2 TB TEST DATE TO). You can narrow the search criteria if more than 1 TB test appears. Below, you can see 7 animals listed based on the search criteria.

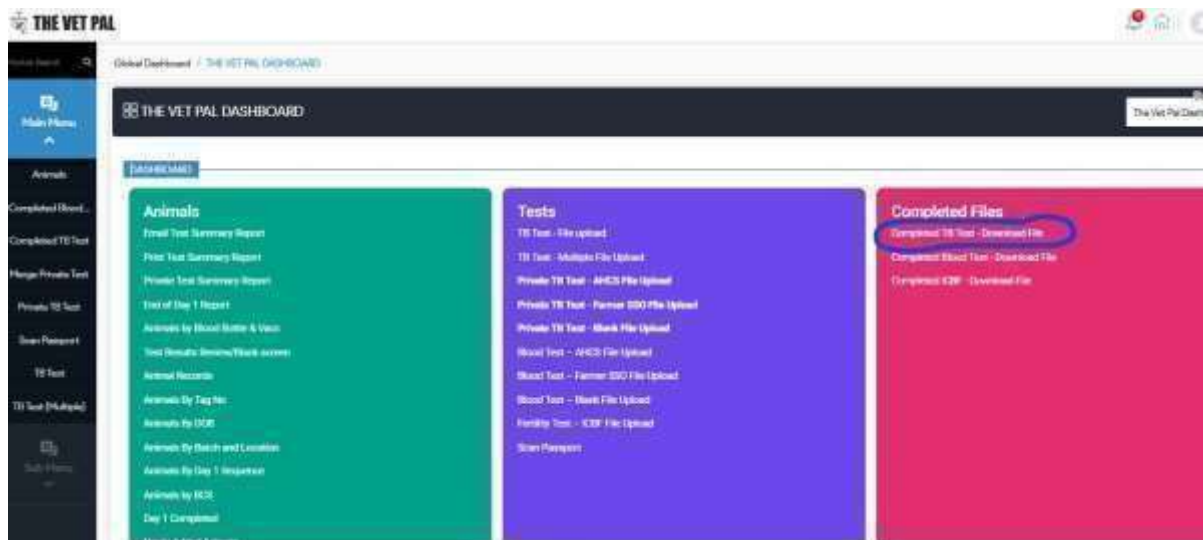

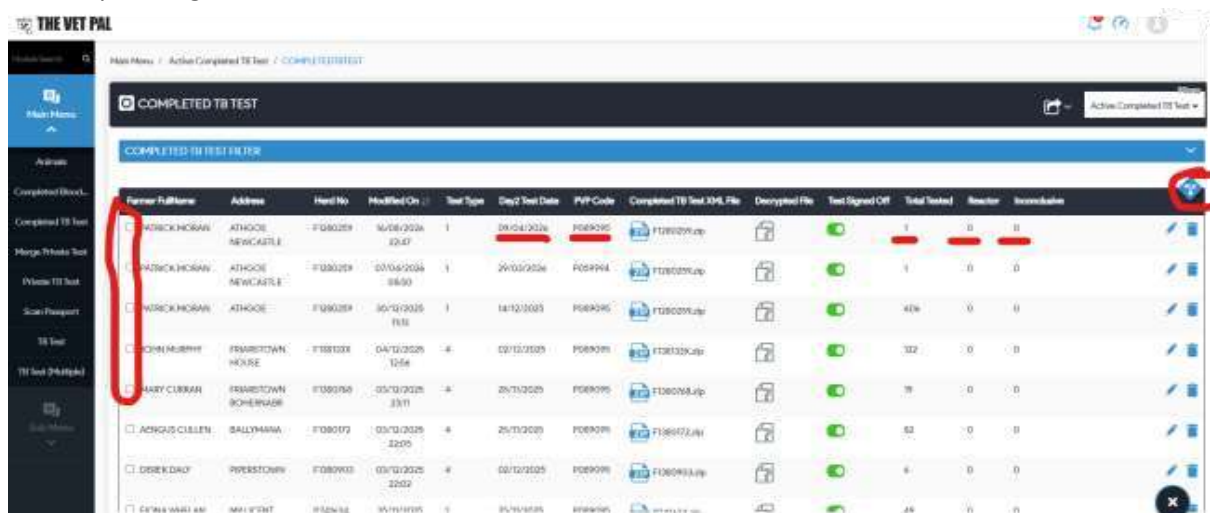

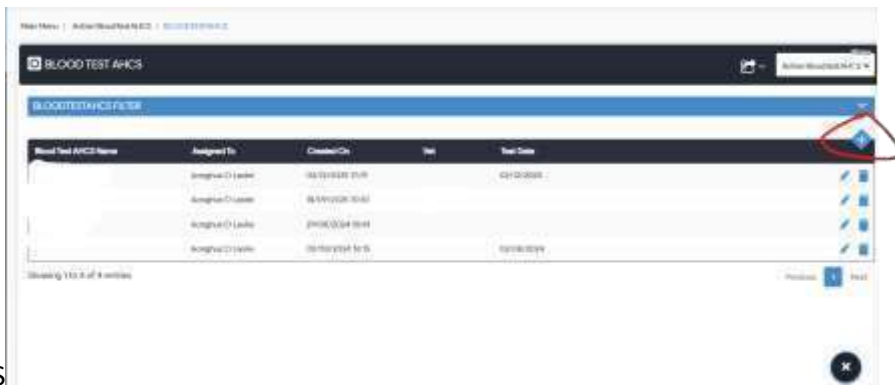
